THE OPEN WATER DIVER CERTIFICATION COURSE.

If you've always wanted to take scuba diving lessons, experience unparalleled adventure and see the world beneath the waves, this is where it starts. Get your scuba diving certification with the Open Water Diver course - the world's most popular and widely recognized scuba course. Millions of people have learned to scuba dive and gone on to discover the wonders of the aquatic world through this course.

To enroll in a SSI Open Water Diver course you must be at least 15 years old, have adequate swimming skills and need to be in good physical health. No prior experience with scuba diving is required. A Junior Open Water Diver program is available for kids 10 to 14 years of age and kids can attend any of our scheduled confined water/pool classes, however the Final Openwater portion of the clas must be conducted through private instruction. Please call the shop for additional requirements and scheduling options.

Here at Dolphin the course can be done in as little as 2 weeks. The class in 2 parts. Part 1 is home study class and pool sessions. Weeknight classes start at 6:30pm and go until about 10pm. The 2-day weekend class starts at 9am and goes until about 4pm on Saturday and Sunday. Part 2 is Open Water dives done over 2 days. There are 3 venues for the dives varying with conditions and time of year. You must complete both parts 1 & 2 to get certified as an open water diver.
