Class + Pool

All tuition must be paid when signing up for the class. The tuition pays for the instructor, classroom, and pool use.

Tuition also covers the use of regulators, Buoyancy Compensator Devices (BCD), tanks, and weights in the pool sessions.

Step 3

Open Water Certification Dives

Local lake: \$149.00

Ocean or Lake Tahoe: \$169.00

Dolphin Scuba Center has a fully stocked Rental Department for the remaining equipment needed for class: tanks, weights, Buoyancy Compensator Device (BCD), regulator, dive computer, wetsuit, hood, and gloves.

Required Personal Equipment

We require each student to be equipped with the following gear: **mask, snorkel, fins, booties**, compass, octo retainer, and whistle.

What to Bring to Class

- 1.) Your **personal equipment** detailed above, **swimsuit**, and a **towel**
- 2.) Your mobile device and charger or your laptop or tablet
- 3.) Pen and notebook for taking notes and completing your exam

Medical/Liability Release

Upon enrolling for class, you will be required to print and fill out a medical statement. If you answer “yes” to any of the questions on the Diver Medical / Participant Questionnaire, you must have a physician’s release signed prior to starting class. Required Homework

By the first night of class, students must have all chapters read and the six Review Sections completed.

Attendance

Classes begin promptly at their scheduled times. You must complete all of the scheduled class sessions before you are eligible to attend the open water certification dives. If it becomes necessary to miss a session, make-up sessions can be scheduled with an instructor for an additional cost of \$30.00 per hour. A seven-days notice is required to pull out of a class. The class tuition may be forfeited if we cannot fill the vacancy. Once the student has started the class, the tuition is assumed earned whether the course is completed or not.
